BASIC FUNCTION:

Under general supervision is responsible for a variety and abundance of manual and maintenance duties in the care and proactive husbandry and welfare of exotic and other zoo managed animals. in the Forest Preserve District’s-Niabi Zoo. Incumbent illustrates good team work and communication skills and provides and implements proper nutrition, behavioral and environmental enrichment and proactive animal husbandry for all animals within the zoo, maintains daily recordkeeping, as assigned welfare and wellness evaluations, assists in the provision of veterinary medical treatment of the collection along with performing general maintenance that include the upkeep of animal habitats and zoo grounds. Incumbent is required to work within teams along with autonomous work throughout the day. The employee receives continuing or individual assignments from the Assistant Director/Curator, generally indicating work to be done, limitations, quality and quantity expected, deadlines and priority of assignments.

SARS-COV-2 (Covid 19 and Variants) PANDEMIC UPDATE:

We are striving to put our employee and animal health and safety first. Facial coverings are required in specific animal areas, veteri-nary and some nutritional prep areas. Proper biosecurity, personal protective equipment and resources are available at all times that include; footbaths, N95 masks along with hand health to ensure a safe work environment for team members and animals.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide appropriate animal husbandry, welfare and wellness for a diverse animal collection.
- Provide proper prescribed nutrition, water and browse for all animals at the zoo. Observes daily activity budgets and ensures/evaluates proper animal welfare and wellness for all animals and their environment. Handles and assists in the operant conditioning and environmental enrichment of animals as required using best practices, industry standards and safety. Provides public keeper chats and guest relations throughout the zoo.
- Assists in the provision of veterinary medical treatment for animals in all capacities.

- Conduct daily husbandry; sanitation/disinfection and all care needs surrounding animal living spaces (habitats and behind the scenes areas).
- Performs general maintenance and lawn care as necessary for zoo grounds.
- Provides security and safety for all animal habitats, behind the scenes spaces and public areas.
- Responds to inquiries from the fellow staff members, vendors/contractors and the general public.
- Contribute to the management of resources and supply stock including transport, stocking and handling.
- Operates trucks, tractors and related vehicles as required and certified. Loads and unloads trucks.
- Prepares and maintains related daily records, quarterly animal evaluations, life event and animal welfare assessments, mobility scoring and all other health and wellness evaluations and related reports.
- Shall assist in emergency response including those occurring before or after normal business hours.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS AND SPECIFICATIONS:

Education, Experience, & License Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in biology or zoology, or related field is required supplemented by two or more years' experience in zoo keeping/managed animal care, and care of exotic animals in a zoo or aquarium setting.
- Must have an appropriate, valid driver's license and a clear background check.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Working knowledge of animal welfare, biotic and abiotic needs of numerous animal species; health, and dietary needs of animals; operant conditioning, environmental enrichment and overall best practices in animal welfare/wellness; animal restraint and safe handling and capture techniques; basic facility maintenance/lawn care; typical behaviors of a variety of animals; zoo operations; public relations techniques.

- Knowledge of basic animal care including related safety precautions. Knowledge of the principles and practices involved in the proactive care of a wide variety of zoo animals within all genera.
- Ability to learn and willingness to adhere to Niabi Zoo/ Rock Island County Forest Preserve District standards and codes, practices, policies and procedures.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective and constructive working relationships within a diverse group of coworkers.
- Ability to perform duties in or on uneven surfaces, extreme heat, cold and in severe weather.
- Ability to communicate with the public tactfully and courteously.
- Ability to communicate clearly both orally and in writing with coworkers, contractors and guests.
- Skill in the physical handling and management of a variety of zoo animals.
- Skill in the operation of maintenance equipment, including, but not limited to motor vehicles, personal computers, hand tools, power tools and related equipment.

Physical Requirements: Task involves the regular, and at times sustained, performance of heavier physical tasks such as walking over rough or uneven surfaces, bending, stooping, working in confined spaces and lifting or carrying moderately heavy (20-75 pound) items and occasionally very heavy (100 pounds or over with team members) items; or may involve the complex operation of gasoline, electric or diesel-powered machinery or shop equipment requiring the manipulation of multiple controls, fine adjustments or both; or the sustained operation, on a production basis.

BASIC FUNCTION:

Under general supervision of department superior, performs semiskilled and skilled maintenance and repair work in a variety of building trades. The employee uses initiative in carrying out recurring assignments independently without specific instructions. The supervisor assures that the work is technically accurate and in compliance with instructions, established procedures and guidelines.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Performs semiskilled and skilled maintenance work in one or more of the building trades; may specialize in a particular craft such as painting, plumbing, carpentry, plastering, electrical work, heating and ventilating work, masonry, carpeting, cement finishing, concrete and ductile iron pipe work or similar craft.
- Participates in preventive maintenance, repairs and new construction.
- Performs repairs to plumbing systems, electrical appliances, climate control systems, roofs and other buildings and facilities.
- Trouble shoots problems; maintains inventory of parts and tools on assigned vehicle; operates hand and power tools and equipment necessary to work assignment.
- Determines supplies and materials needed to make various repairs.
- Shall assist in emergencies.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
