

The Rock Island District's Operations Division is responsible for the safe, reliable, and efficient operation and maintenance of the District's civil works projects. This includes the management of 3 flood control reservoirs in Iowa—Saylorville Lake, Lake Red Rock, and Coralville Lake. These multi-use projects provide primary benefits in flood control and low flow augmentation and the secondary benefits of recreation, fish and wildlife management, forest management and water quality improvement. The District's Lake Managers, Park Rangers, staff and volunteers actively manage the natural resources, river, woodland, wetland, and prairie habitats and take great pride in offering quality outdoor recreation including camping, boating, fishing, hiking, biking, wildlife watching and more. Currently, our District is seeking an experienced Natural Resources Management Specialist (Ranger) at the Coralville Lake Project, where your responsibilities will include:

- Natural resources management, recreation, visitor assistance, contract administration, environmental stewardship, public outreach, and interpretive services.
- Preparing various planning documents for assigned program(s), to include the Reservoir Regulation Plan, Emergency Action Plan, Operation and Maintenance Manual, Operational Management Plan (OMP), Master Plan, Project Safety Plan, Fire Prevention Plan, Asset Management, Periodic Assessments/Dam Safety, Shoreline Management Plan (as applicable), and Physical Security Plan.
- Overseeing the conservation, preservation, restoration and use of all project natural resources.

Develops guidelines, standards and procedures for analyzing public needs, demands, site carrying capacities, natural resource and recreation program capabilities.

- Serving as a Contracting Officer Representative (COR) in the preparation and administration of contracts. Contracts include projects for park attendant, custodial, refuse removal, law enforcement, communication systems, supplies and materials, construction/service indefinite delivery indefinite quantity (IDIQ) task orders, and facilities and equipment.
- The administration and management of all outgranted lands, inspecting outgrants for compliance with terms of environmental regulations to ensure outgrant activities comply with terms of agreed management plans.
- Enforcing Title 36 CFR Section 327 and local/district policies on all USACE lands and waters, issuing warnings or citations to violators, and attending federal magistrate court as required.

The outside work may be at construction areas or areas of rugged topography and thick vegetation. Contact with poison ivy, ticks, mosquitoes are common occurrences. Employees are required to follow established safe working procedures. Physical

activity is also required while performing inspections and other duties at the dam and levees. May require frequent lifting of moderately heavy items or equipment up to 50 pounds.
